



YOU&ME GUIDE

Main functions

You&Me can calculate (starting from the date/time of a special event of you life) and **remind you any anniversary** (such as 1 million minutes or 10 years wedding anniversary) with an **automatic notification message** (Anniversary mode).

You&Me allows you to **schedule/remind any future single event/task** (such as dates, dinners, appointments, meetings, ..) with an **automatic notification message** (Date mode).

You&Me also allows you to place a **countdown widget of a future event**.

You&Me also allows you to **remember any past life event** (such as wedding date) and place on the home page a **count up widget**.

Quick start:

1. click on the **Create events** button
2. enter the required information
3. **to create multiple anniversaries for past events** select **Recent, Any, or Remote modes**
4. **to create future (or past) single events** such as dates/tasks select the **Date mode**
5. click on the Save button
6. click on the **Show events** button
7. check your anniversaries or dates
8. **a long click on the event row** displays a list of possible actions (send SMS/email/call, Export to calendar, Export to countdown widget* , Export to count up widget* , enable/disable, re-create, delete event/group/all)

*Remember that a **widget must be added to the home screen before exporting to it the event data** (in Android 3/4 you can find widgets in the applications menu, in the widget category; in Android 2 after a long tap on home screen select the widget menu)

Start Page

Button functions:

1. **Show Events**: it displays the list of all the present (from 1 day before) and future scheduled anniversaries and tasks; past anniversaries and tasks may be shown using the Search menu function.
2. **Create Events**: it creates all the requested anniversaries and tasks for the specified life or future event; remember that new anniversaries with the same Title and Name replace the old ones.
3. **Help** : it shows the user guide (PDF).

Menu functions:

1. **HELP**: it shows the app help
2. **SETTINGS**: app settings page
3. **HELP US**: email link to our service

Create Events Page

This page creates all the requested anniversaries or task for the specified event; remember that new events with the same Title and Name replace the old ones.

Selection buttons:

1. **WHAT:** it shows a **list of choices** for the event title; with a click on the text area it is **possible to type any user title**
2. **WHO:** it shows a **list of choices** for the partner's name (the list is generated from the mobile address book); with a click on the text area it is **possible to type any partner's name** (but remember that in this way you loose any possible automatic link with the partner mobile address)
3. **WHEN:** it shows a **date/time selector** in order to specify the life event date/time;
4. **MODE:** it shows a **list of choices** (**Recent, Any, Remote** to create many anniversaries and **Date** for single tasks/events) for the event event creation mode;
5. **DESC:** with a click on the text area it is **possible to type any description**;

Event creation modes:

1. **RECENT** : this mode is suitable for recent events (**less than 1 year old**) and it generates anniversaries using a geometric formula with a multiplication factor (x) of 10 (for instance for hours it calculates the following anniversaries: 1,000 10,000 100,000); the behavior can be personalized in the settings page.
2. **ANY** : this mode is suitable for any **past event** and it generates anniversaries using an arithmetic formula with a fixed step (for instance for hours it calculates the anniversaries every 1,000 hours); the behavior can be personalized in the settings page.
3. **REMOTE** : this mode is suitable for remote events (**more than 1 year old**) and it generates anniversaries using an arithmetic formula with a fixed step (for instance for hours it calculates the anniversaries every 10,000 hours); the behavior can be personalized in the settings page.
4. **DATE**: this mode is suitable for **future (or past) single** events/tasks (such as dates, appointments, dinner) and it adds only the specified event (one, NO anniversaries)

Toolbar and menu functions:

1. **SAVE:** if Recent/Any/Remote mode is selected it creates the anniversaries of the past event for the **next 5 years** (default: it can be changed in the settings page); if Date mode is selected it creates a single event with the specified date/time.
2. **HELP:** it shows the app help
3. **BACK:** returns to the Start page

Show Events Page

This page shows the list of all the present (starting from 1 day before) and future scheduled events (anniversaries/tasks); disabled events (no notification messages) have a * tag on the date; past events (anniversaries/tasks) may be shown using the Search menu function.

A long press on a event row shows the following possible actions:

1. **Send SMS:** it activates your SMS app, enters the mobile number of your partner, enters the event data in the text area, displays the SMS and waits for your editing/sending possible actions.
2. **Send EMAIL:** it activates your EMAIL app, enters the email address of your partner, enters the event data in the subject and text area, displays the EMAIL and waits for your editing/sending possible actions.
3. **Call mobile:** it calls the mobile of your partner

4. **Export to calendar:** it exports the event data to the default Google Calendar (and if required it displays it)
5. **Export to countDown widget:** it exports the displayed event data to the You&Me countdown widget (it is necessary to add the countdown widget on the home page before the export action)
6. **Export to countUp widget:** it exports the life event data (the original event saved in the creation step) to the You&Me count up widget (it is necessary to add the count up widget on the home page before the export action)
7. **Enable event:** it activates events that where previously disabled (with manual or automatic actions).
8. **Disable event:** it deactivates events that where previously enabled (they will not be considered in any notification message)
9. **Re-Create events:** it displays the Create Events page with all the info of the life event that was entered to generate the selected event: it is possible to generate new events replacing the old ones.
10. **Delete event:** it deletes the current displayed event

11. **Delete group:** it deletes the current event group (all the events with the same title and name)
12. **Delete all:** it deletes all the events

How to add a widget to your home screen:

- Android 3.x, 4.x: you can find widgets in applications menu, in the widget category
- Android 2.x: long tap on home screen, then select widgets menu

Menu functions:

1. **SEARCH:** it shows the search options (Schedule, All, Name, Title) and filters the events accordingly
2. **SORT:** it shows the sort options (Date, Name, Title) and sorts the events accordingly
3. **HELP:** it shows the app help

Settings Page

This page allows to personalize all the app settings (access from the Start Page menu):

1. **Wallpapers:** it is possible to select the favorite wallpaper (default: sky)
2. **Date icon:** it is possible to select an icon for the events created with the Date mode (default: clock)
3. **Anniversary icon:** it is possible to select an icon for the events created with the Anniversary modes (default: glasses)
4. **Button color:** it is possible to specify a button background color (default: pink)
5. **Frame color:** it is possible to specify a frame background color (default: black)
6. **Enable Notification:** it is possible to specify if the app has sent notifications to remind anniversaries/tasks (default on).
7. **Reminder anticipation:** it is possible to specify notification anticipation in minutes (default 15)
8. **Enable Alarm:** it is possible to enable the alarm ring tone (default off): effective only if the Notification id enabled
9. **Enable Vibration:** it is possible to enable the vibration (default off):

effective only if the Notification id enabled

10. **Recent event mode** : in this category it is possible to set all the parameters of the Recent event mode
11. **Any event mode** : in this category it is possible to set all the parameters of the Any event mode
12. **Remote event mode** : in this category it is possible to set all the parameters of the Remote event mode

To disable a mode parameter, set it to 0 .

It is possible to **revert to the default** settings with a **long click on the You&Me label** of the Start Page.
